

SOMETHING TO CROW ABOUT 2

(Follow-up to “Something to Crow About”)

Message: God made everything

Scripture: Exodus 20:11



Last week I told you a story about a rooster. Do you remember his name? It was Rusty the Rooster. I told you that Rusty lived on a farm and that it was his job to wake up all the animals on the farm. So each morning Rusty would hop on top of the hen house, and when the sun came up he would crow at the top of his lungs. Then all the horses, the cows, the pigs, the goats and the chickens would wake up.

But there's one thing I didn't tell you before. After months of crowing at the sun every morning Rusty began to think that it was he who made the sun come up. You see, he figured, “I crow, and the sun comes up, so my crowing must have made the sun come up.”

What do you think? Do you think a rooster can make the sun come up? No! Who does make the sun come up? God! God makes the sun come up. In fact God controls everything because God made everything. Exodus 20, verse 11 says, “For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them.” (NIV)

God made everything: the sun, the moon, the stars, the earth, the sea and everything that's in them – including you and me. That's the kind of God we worship.
